

# ROULETTE

## **Roulette is an exciting game of chance.**

A Double Zero Roulette wheel has thirty-six (36) numbers from 1 to 36, 0 and 00. The numbers are alternately colored red and black with 0 and 00 colored green. The Roulette layout is numbered and colored the same as the Roulette wheel. A Double Zero Roulette wheel has 38 equally-spaced compartments on the wheel.

Players may place bets with colored Roulette chips on any number or combination of numbers on the Roulette table. Chips are sold as a single color to a player to differentiate between multiple players. The color chip values are determined by the amount the player pays for the original stack of 20.

The Roulette wheel is spun in one direction while the dealer spins the Roulette ball in the opposite direction. Players may place bets on any number, combination of numbers or section of numbers, red or black colors, odd or even numbers or 0 and/or 00. The dealer signals the end of betting by saying, "No more bets." Please remember, where players place their chips on the Roulette table determines their bet and the player is responsible for the chips' correct placement. After the ball falls onto a number on the Roulette wheel, the dealer calls out the winning number and places the marker "Dolly" on it. All losing bets are collected and winning bets are paid.

**Note:** Value chips can be utilized at the discretion of the dealer/supervisor.

# CRISS CROSS POKER

Valley Forge Casino Resort now offers a new exciting poker game called Criss Cross Poker. The game is played with a single 52-card deck. Two five card hands - Win across, Win Down or Win Both.

## HOW TO PLAY

Begin by making two ante bets of equal value-an "Ante Across" wager and an "Ante Down" wager. An optional 5 Card bonus bet is also available.

The Dealer will deal 5 community cards face down in such a way that they form a cross. Each player then receives 2 cards face down. Players examine their cards and either fold or make an "Across Bet" of 1X to 3X their Ante Across bet. The Dealer will expose 2 outside cards on the horizontal line of the cross. Players may then fold or make a "Down Bet" of 1X to 3X their "Ante Down" bet. The Dealer will expose 2 outside cards on the vertical line of the cross. You may then fold or make a "Middle Bet" of 1X to 3X one of the ante bets. The Dealer then turns over the middle card. Players use their two cards and the three community cards on the horizontal line to form an Across hand. Players use their same two cards plus the three community cards on the vertical line to form a Down hand. Winning Across and Down bets are paid according to the payable listed below. The Middle bet is paid if either the Across or Down hand qualify as a win and is paid at the odds of the higher ranking hand. The two Ante bets are paid even money on a pair of Jacks or better and push on pair of 6's through 10's.

The 5 Card Bonus is based on the five community cards making the best 5 Card Bonus hand. This wager will remain in action until the conclusion of the hand even if you have folded at any time during the hand. The 5 Card Bonus is paid according to the payable listed below.
